

VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The New Jersey State Elks Association is pleased to present its Vocational Scholarship for students who have completed their secondary education requirements and plan to attend a post-secondary school to pursue a certificate or credential in a vocational or technical program. Post-secondary schools include vocational or technical schools. Students attending a two year community college are also eligible as long as they are pursuing a certificate or credential. Students planning to earn an Associate's or Bachelor's Degree are not eligible for this scholarship program.

This scholarship is available to graduating high school students or within four years of earning a high school diploma or GED. Applicant must be a resident of New Jersey and must also be a citizen of the United States on the date that the application is submitted.

All applications must be sent to your local New Jersey Elks Lodge and postmarked between March 6, 2024 & May 13, 2024 for the 2023-24 academic year. For assistance in locating the nearest lodge, use the following website: <http://www.elks.org/lodges/>
